



How to find us

The Schwebodrom is located at Werth 96 in the heart of the city center of Wuppertal-Barmen.

Via Schwebebahn:

From the main station (Wuppertal Hauptbahnhof), take the Schwebebahn towards Oberbarmen and get off at **Werther Brücke station A.**

Via train: Take the regional express or S-Bahn to **Bahn-hof Barmen B**. From there ca. 15 minutes by foot.

By car: Use the numerous parking spaces in the area. For example at the town hall, Große Flurstraße 41 **C.**






Through the Wupper Valley in the original wagon 11 -A virtual journey back in time to 1929
